CHURCH BULLETIN COVER DESIGN CONTEST

Fairfield Methodist Church (FFMC) is committed to be a disciple making church. This contest seeks to convey that vision into the cover of the church's bulletin. Therefore, the theme of the cover must convey the vision of a disciple making church. We hope that the cover will help members and worshippers to remember and to commit to grow as disciple-makers in a disciple making church.

A past Church Bulletin dated 19 June 2016 is provided after page 4 of this rules and general information. Please note that this Contest includes the front and back cover of the bulletin. Contestants must ensure that the name and logo of Fairfield Methodist Church and date of the bulletin must appear on the front cover of the bulletin. The rest of the information on the cover may be ignored. All the details of the back cover in the past bulletin provided must be included in the design for the back cover.

CHURCH BULLETIN CONTENT LAYOUT CONTEST

While the Fairfield Methodist Church (FFMC) seeks to convey the vision of a disciple making church in the Bulletin Cover Design Contest, we take this opportunity to enhance and refresh the layout and general look of the content of the bulletin at the same time. We hope that members and worshippers can find it easy and pleasing to the eye to refer to the announcements and information in the bulletin as changes are made to the layout and general look of the content.

A past Church Bulletin dated 19 June 2016 is provided after page 4 of this rules and general information. Please note that all the announcements that appeared in the past bulletin and the Order of Worship must be included in the new layout design.

THE RULES

The following rules cover both the Church Bulletin Cover Design Contest and the Church Bulletin Content Layout Contest.

1. ***HOW TO PARTICIPATE*** – Visit www.fairfieldmc.org from 15 July 2016 and follow the directions provided. Limit of three (3) entries per person per Contest using only one (1) NRIC/Passport number throughout the Contest Period. Entrants must send entries using the specific entry information requested in the contest announcement available at the church's website. Eligibility of individual entries will be at the sole discretion of the judges of the Contests, for any reason or for no reason, though specific reasons for disqualification may include use of inappropriate language or visuals. FFMC is not responsible for and will not consider incomplete or incorrect entries. Multiple entries received from any person in excess of the stated limitation will be void. All entries become the sole property of FFMC and will not be returned.
2. ***CONTEST PERIOD*** – The Contests begin at 12:00 am on July 15, 2016 and end at 11:59 pm on August 15, 2016. Entries submitted before or after the Contest Period will not be eligible. FFMC's computer is the official time-keeping device for the Contests.

3. **ELIGIBILITY** – The Contests are open to all who are worshipping in Fairfield Methodist Church or Fairfield Preaching Point.
4. **JUDGING** –
- (A) Entries will be judged on originality, overall impact, artistic merit and subject matter relevant to the cover and content of the church’s bulletin. Judging will be conducted by a panel of guest judges selected by the Pastors, LCEC Leader and Lay Leader of FFMC at its sole discretion. The judges will evaluate all valid entries and pick the winning entries. The decision of the judges is final and binding.
- (B) Judges for the contests are:
- i. Mr Eric Quah who is the LCEC Chairperson of Fairfield Methodist Church.
 - ii. Mr Tan Chee Boon who is the Lay Leader of Fairfield Methodist Church.
 - iii. Ms Corinne Tan worships in Kampong Kapur Methodist Church with her family and serves as a teacher in the Young Adult Ministry. She is co-founder and principal consultant of Impressions PR Pte Ltd. She has worked in a varied range of industries: from advertising, hospitality, the arts, property development, management consultancy.
 - iv. Ms Glacy Soh is a member of Wesley Methodist Church and served as the Sunday School Superintendent and, together with her family, are active in various ministries in the church. She is now actively serving in the church’s Children Ministry. She is a homemaker turned artist and is the owner of GlacySoh Art - an art company that sells her paintings, commissioned artworks, design work and sale of original and customized merchandise.
5. **DETAILS FOR SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES** – All entries must be in A5 sized format in either black and white or colour prints.
- (A) All entries must be submitted via email in Microsoft Word format to bulletindesign@fairfieldmc.org by the closing date.
- (B) All entries must be accompanied by your name, NRIC or Passport Number, contact telephone/mobile number, and home address.
- (C) To ensure eligibility for the contest, please submit files no larger than 20MB at the time of entry. Higher resolution files of at least 240 dpi/ppi will be requested should an entry be preselected to be awarded a prize.
- (D) By entering, you indicate your unconditional agreement to, and acceptance of, these Official Rules and judges’ decisions, which are final and binding. You cannot win a prize unless you comply with all requirements in these Official Rules.
6. **PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION** – By submitting any entry to either or both of the Contests, you do so acknowledge that Fairfield Methodist Church is collecting and using your personal data for administration and communication purposes relating to the Contest and gives consent to Fairfield Methodist Church collecting, using or disclosing your personal data for the purpose of contacting you via

telephone/sending phone messages/email/mails relating to the above stated purposes.

- (A) By submitting any photos, graphics, designs or information to this contest, you hereby represent and warrant that the submitted photos, graphics, designs or information do not and shall not infringe on any copyright, any rights of privacy or publicity of any person, or any other right of any third party, and you have the right to grant any and all rights and licenses to FFMC, including but not limited to all necessary rights under copyright, free and clear of any claims or encumbrances.
- (B) You acknowledge and agree that FFMC shall have no obligation to post, display or otherwise make publicly available any photos, graphics, designs or information submitted by you, and may, in its sole and unfettered discretion, remove, edit, modify or delete any photo or information that you submit to FFMC.
- (C) You understand and intend that any photos, graphics, designs or information submitted by you to FFMC may be available for viewing, rating, review and comment on by the public. By submitting any photos, graphics, designs or information to FFMC, you hereby waive any privacy expectations that you may have with respect to any such photos, graphics, designs or information submitted by you to FFMC.
- (D) You hereby agree to waive any right to pursue, any claims of any nature arising in connection with the inclusion in, publication via or display on any FFMC site, or any other use authorized by FFMC of any photos, graphics, designs or information submitted by you to FFMC.
- (E) By submitting any photos, graphics, designs or information to this contest, you hereby grant to FFMC an irrevocable, perpetual and royalty-free right to use, reproduce, edit, display, transmit, prepare derivative works of, modify, publish and otherwise make use of the submitted photos, graphics, designs or information in any and all media, whether now known or hereinafter created for any purpose. The rights granted to FFMC includes but is not limited to the right to resize, crop, censor, compress, edit, feature, caption, affix logos to, and to otherwise alter or make use of the submitted photos, graphics, designs or information.
- (F) In the event that the operation or administration of the Contest is impaired in any way, FFMC may, in its sole discretion, either: (a) suspend the Contest to address the impairment and then resume the Photo Contest; or (b) award the prize(s) from among the eligible entries received up to the time of the impairment.

- (B) All prizes must be collected within 30 days of being notified of winning at the email address used to enter. Failure to respond shall mean that the winner forfeits the prize.

- (C) FFMC is not required to award any prizes forfeited by the chosen winner(s).

- (D) All winners are required to show their original identification card/passport upon collection of prizes. For winners who are unable to collect their prizes personally, a letter of authorisation is required. The person collecting in proxy must produce the winner's original IC/passport/ Photo ID (with name, photo & IC No) for collection.
