### **Theme & Objectives**

#### **1. What are the objectives of the SG Summit 2026?**

- a. To give extended opportunities for SG members within the same SG to strengthen bonds with one another.
- b. To give opportunities for different SGs to encourage one another in intentional disciple-making.
- c. To allow individuals interested in joining an SG who are not yet in an SG to integrate quickly into an SG.
- d. To encourage SG members to relate as friends with other individuals in SGs within and outside of SGs to help them grow as Christian disciples.

#### **3. Who is the speaker for the SG Summit?**

The main speaker is **Rev Dr Andrew Tan**.

Rev. Dr. Andrew Tan has been a pastor for more than 40 years. He grew up in Penang. He studied theology and graduated with B Div. from Trinity Theological College, Singapore, in 1983. He received his MA in Counseling from Asbury Theological Seminary in 2002, and his D Min. in 2011. He has been pastor of Kampar Wesley (1983-1987), Canning Garden Methodist Church, Ipoh (1988-2000), Kuala Lumpur Wesley (2002-2010), and Emmanuel Methodist Church, PJ (2011-2017) before returning to Canning Methodist Church, Ipoh (2018-2023). Rev. Andrew Tan married Anna in 1982, and they have two children, David and Caryn

No. If children or youth are coming along, they are welcome to join in the main teaching sessions.


## Accommodation

### 6. Where is the SG Summit held?

The Summit will be held at Z hotel, Johor Bahru.

Z hotel is located at [No. 18, Jalan Wong Ah Fook, 80888 Ibrahim International Business District, Johor Darul Ta'zim.](#)

It is a 9 min walk from CIQ (about 700m), and an 8 min Grab ride from Larkin Terminal



**7. How much does accommodation cost?**

As at 1 Feb 2026, a room for 2 at Z Hotel is available at an early sign-up rate of about **\$159.08** (for 2 nights, *before taxes*). You are encouraged to sign up early to secure a cheaper rate. We are unable to guarantee that the rate will not go up closer to the date of the Summit.

**8. How do I book my accommodation?**

Participants are strongly encouraged to book directly with **Z Hotel, Johor Bahru** at <https://www.z-hotel.my/booking/>

**9. Is the accommodation booking included in the SG Summit registration?**

No, accommodation is not included. Participants are responsible for booking their own rooms directly with the hotel.

**10. Can I book accommodation at a hotel other than Z hotel?**

Yes, you may. We understand that some SGs may wish to book alternative accommodation. This is fine so long as members are prepared to make transport arrangements for travel to and from Z hotel for the combined sessions.

**11. Will there be a registration fee for the summit?**

No.

## **Transport**

### **12. Will transport be provided?**

We regret that we are unable to make transport arrangements given SG Comm's limited resources. Participants are encouraged to carpool or make their way there via public bus. Z hotel is located very close to the CIQ building (700m walk).

### **13. Is there parking available at the Z hotel?**

**18. What is the deadline for signing up?**

The deadline for signing up is **31 May 2026.**

You are strongly encouraged to sign up early to secure the early booking rate for accommodation (see FAQ 7 above).
